Competencies in Math 15 (5-credits) will cover topics including number sense, logical reasoning, measurement, algebra, graphical reasoning, statistics and probability. The course will enhance numeracy skills in students, develop their critical thinking and problem solving abilities, and set them up for success in future courses in mathematics. This course is recommended for students who demonstrated basic achievement of Grade 9 Math curriculum and were challenged by algebra, exponents, fractions and problem solving in Math 9.
