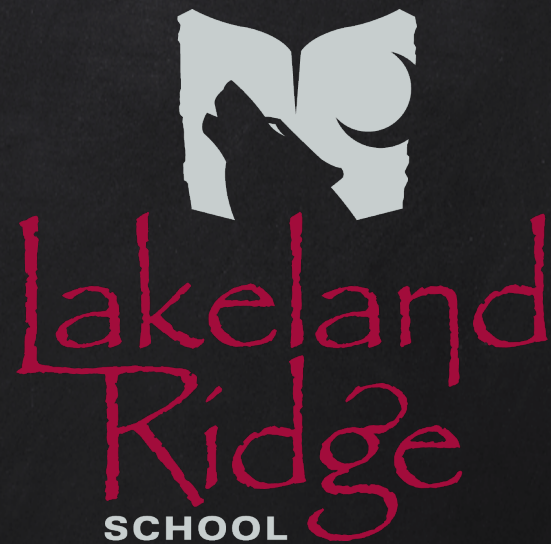

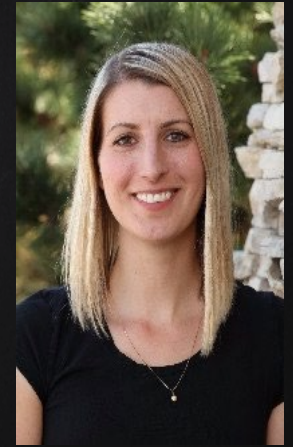

- ★ K-9 School

 - 800 students projected in K-9 (350 in Junior High)

Junior High Life

★ What's New?

- Different teachers for different subjects
- Change classrooms for different subjects
- CHOICE! Students get to select option courses
- New opportunities - athletics, ski trip, drama production
- More freedom during morning and lunch breaks



Lunch Break

- ★ Junior high students eat lunch in designated areas throughout the school and can choose who they want to eat with
- ★ Junior high students are allowed to leave the school grounds during the lunch break
- ★ Supervision: library, gathering area, gym, hallway and outside
- ★ Hot lunches can be pre-ordered once or twice a month
(Organized by the Parent Action Society)



Junior High Schedule

- ★ Six day cycle
- ★ Six periods per day
- ★ 2 Semesters
 - Core courses are full-year
 - Options are semestered except French
- ★ Period 1 is 55 minutes, periods 2-6 are 53 minutes
- ★ 15 minute locker break in the morning, 45 minute lunch break

Junior High Options

- ★ Option selections have already occurred through Powerschool. All students had an opportunity to select their top 12 option choices and administration is using those to create student timetables.

Student Assessment

- ★ Percentage marks in core subjects
- ★ Letter grades in other courses
- ★ PowerSchool Parent Portal (Access marks)
- ★ Student / Parent / Teacher conferences
- ★ Digital report cards in November & March
- ★ Final exams in June
- ★ Academic concerns should be addressed first with teachers
