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We are on Indigenous land in Treaty 6 territory.

This place, ᑭᓐᓃᑦᓱᑦᑲᓐᓇᑦᑲᓐᓱᓐᓱᓐ, Amiskwacîwâskahikan (Edmonton) – is the traditional meeting ground, gathering place, and travelling route of the Nêhiyawak (Cree), Anishinaabe (Saulteaux), Niitsitapi (Blackfoot), Michif (Métis), Dene, and Nakota.

TRADITIONAL SKILL WORKSHOPS INCLUDE:

- traditional skill instruction
- Metis cultural teachings and exhibit of related cultural items
- how to select and where to purchase materials
- video tutorials included

Travel Fee: no charge in Beaumont, Edmonton Devon, Leduc, Sherwood Park, Stony Plain, Spruce Grove, St Albert; 50 km or more from Beaumont is \$1.00/kilometer (plus hotel if applicable)



Simple Beaded Pouch Workshop (grades 4-6)

Students will learn basic beading and hand sewing techniques to make a cotton beaded pouch to take home.

Workshop: 2 hours

Instructional Fee: \$250

Supplies: \$5 per student

Adults Needed: 1 adult per 5 students (can be waived during covid restrictions)



Metis Art Workshop (grades 3-6)

Students will complete three projects to take home; one of each of the following art: beading, dot art and sash finger braiding

Instructional Fee: \$250

Supplies: \$5 per student

Adults Needed: 1 adult per 5 students (can be waived during covid restrictions)



Quick Projects: Beading Workshop (grades 7-12)

Students will make one beaded project to take home. The class must all make the same project. Great gift ideas. Choose from either: (large size 6 glass beads used)

- strawberry key chain
- orange shirt pin
- flower hair tie or bracelet

Workshop:

- 2 sessions
- 6 hours of instruction time in total; 3 hours for beading instruction and 3 hours for backing instruction
- beading and backing instructional sessions should be at least one week apart
- students will need some work time in between instructional sessions to complete beading

Instruction Fee: \$550

Supplies: \$5 per student



Beading Workshops (grades 7-12)

Students will make one beaded project to take home. The class must all make the same project. Choose from either: (small size 11 glass beads used)

- melton beaded pouch
- beaded poppy
- beaded orange shirt

Workshop:

- 2 sessions
- 6 hours of instruction time in total; 3 hours for beading instruction and 3 hours for backing/pouch sewing instruction
- beading and backing/sewing instructional sessions should be at least one week apart
- students will need some work time in between instructional sessions to complete beading

Instruction Fee: \$550

Supplies:

- beaded pouch \$20 per student
- beaded poppy or orange shirt \$15



Wool Mittens with Embroidery or Beading

Students will make one pair of wool mittens lined with fleece. The class must all bead or all embroider.

Workshop:

- 2 sessions
- 6 hours of instruction time in total; 3 hours for beading/embroidery instruction and 3 hours for mitten sewing instruction
- beading/embroidery and sewing instructional sessions should be at least one week apart
- students will need some work time in between instructional sessions to complete beading/embroidery

Instruction Fee: \$550

Supplies: \$10 per student



Wool Eye Glass with Embroidery or Beading

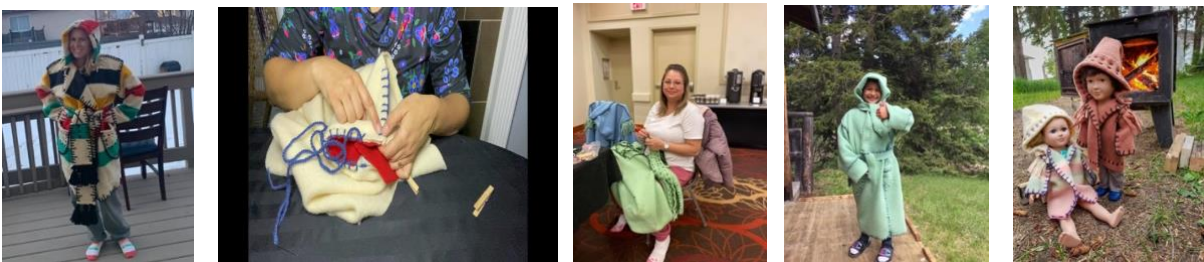
Students will make one wool eye glass case. The class must all bead or all embroider.

Workshop:

- 2 sessions
- 6 hours of instruction time in total; 3 hours for beading/embroidery instruction and 3 hours for eye glass sewing instruction
- beading/embroidery and sewing instructional sessions should be at least one week apart
- students will need some work time in between instructional sessions to complete beading/embroidery

Instruction Fee: \$550

Supplies: \$10 per student



Kickin' Capote Workshop

Workshop:

- 9 hours needed to complete
- usually 3 sessions of 3 hours each but alternate arrangements can be made

Instruction Fee: \$750

Supplies: \$60 per student
