PowerSchool Mobile Apps Frequently Asked Questions.

How do I find my district code?

The district code appears on the PowerSchool Student and Parent portal:

- 1. Open a browser and sign in to your PowerSchool Student or Parent portal.
- 2. Make note of the district code value that appears on the bottom left corner of the navigation menu.
 - **Note:** If you do not see a district code, mobile services may not be enabled for PowerSchool. Contact your district administrator for more information.
- 3. Open the PowerSchool Student or Parent mobile app and enter the district code on the sign in screen.
- 4. If you enter a valid district code, a green checkmark appears next to the District Code field
- 5. Enter your username and password and sign in to the PowerSchool mobile app.

Why is the sync with PowerSchool taking a long time?

The PowerSchool server or the mobile app may be timing-out when syncing data with PowerSchool. The default timeout value is five minutes. Tap on Live Feed on the left menu, and then tap Refresh in the top right corner of the screen. This starts the sync process on the server. Wait up to five or more minutes. You will know that the sync process has completed when the spinner in the status bar (iOS) or animation (Android) stops.


The following instructions are for the iOS version of the mobile app:

Look in the System Logs on the mobile app to determine if there are any messages related to the sync issue.

- 1. Open the side menu.
- 2. Scroll down, then tap **Application Settings**.
- 3. Scroll down, then tap **System Logs**.
- 4. You should see success and failure logs that happen when you sign in and sync data with PowerSchool.
- 5. You should be able to tap on the last failure log to view more information.

When To Use The Student Portal?

Students may only book flex sessions using the PowerSchool web portal through a normal web browser session by connecting to EIPS via the school guest wireless network at https://powerschool.eips.ca/public/home.html and clicking on the "Flex Session" icon.



Flex sessions **cannot** be booked by using an Android or IOS PowerSchool public application.

Working with Mobile Apps

Connecting Mobile Apps to PowerSchool


After a user downloads the mobile app to their device, the app will need to point to the correct PowerSchool server to authenticate. The Parent and Student apps walk the user through an on-boarding process. Most users will enter a four-character code that is used to locate the PowerSchool server. If a user does not know their District Code, they can search for their district by district name or school name.

They can also manually enter the PowerSchool server URL. In either case, the mobile apps will search for the district code via PowerSource and/or connect via the server if the mobile services are accessible.

District Code

The district code is a four-character code that can be entered on the sign in screen to point the mobile apps to the PowerSchool mobile services. This code is auto generated when the PowerSchool server is registered with PowerSource. The district code should never change for your district. If PowerSchool registers with a new domain name, the district code will update to the new domain name.

Anytime the district code is updated, it will be validated with PowerSource. If a red X appears next to the code, the entry is invalid and the user will need to enter the correct district code.



If a green check appears, the district code is registered to a valid PowerSchool server.





Mobile Apps

PowerSchool Mobile apps include:

- PowerSchool for Parents (phones and tablets for iOS and Android devices)
- PowerSchool for Students (phones and tablets for iOS and Android devices)



To automatically discover the District Code click on the blue link "Where is my district code?"






Locate your district code on the bottom left corner of the navigation menu on the PowerSchool public portal.

The District Code Help window is displayed. Click on the blue bar to "Search for Your District"




The Search for PowerSchool is displayed. Within the "District Name" box type Elk Island Public




Next click the blue "Search" button.
