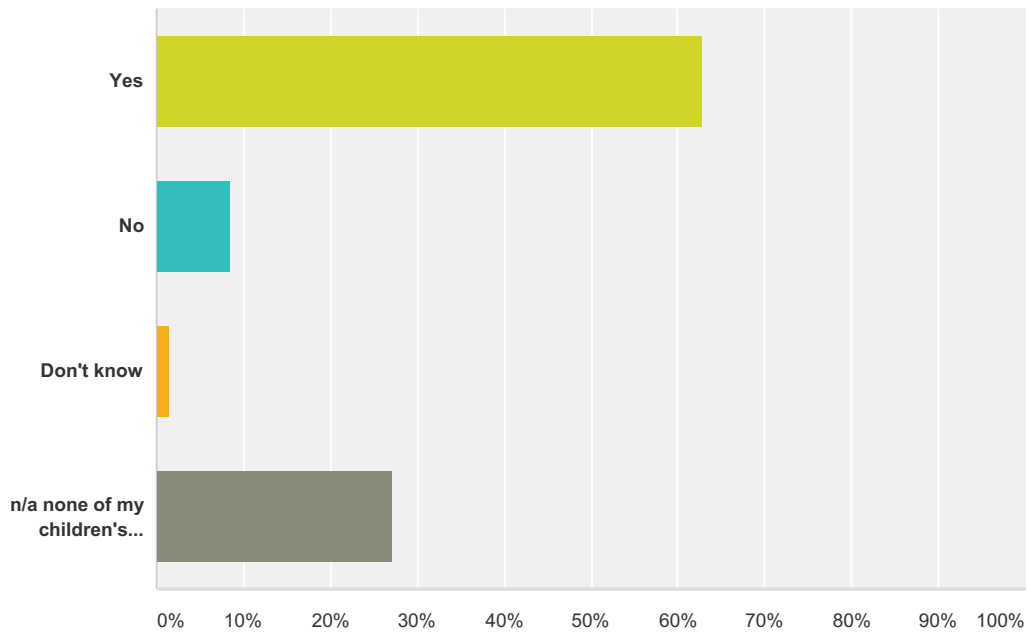


Q1 Has your child ever complained about the portable classrooms being too hot?

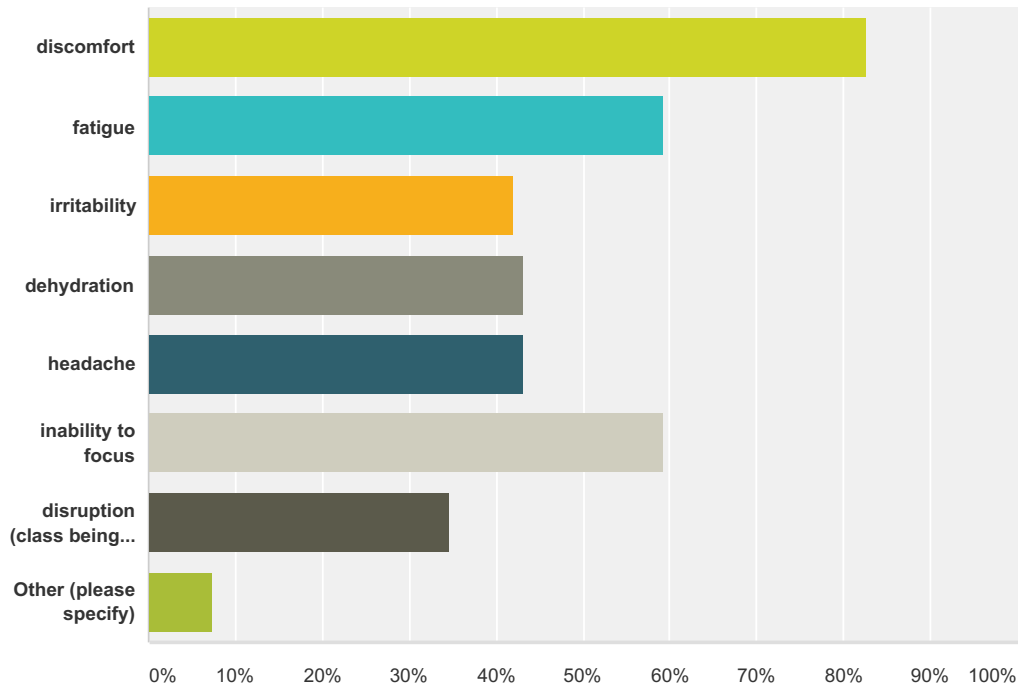

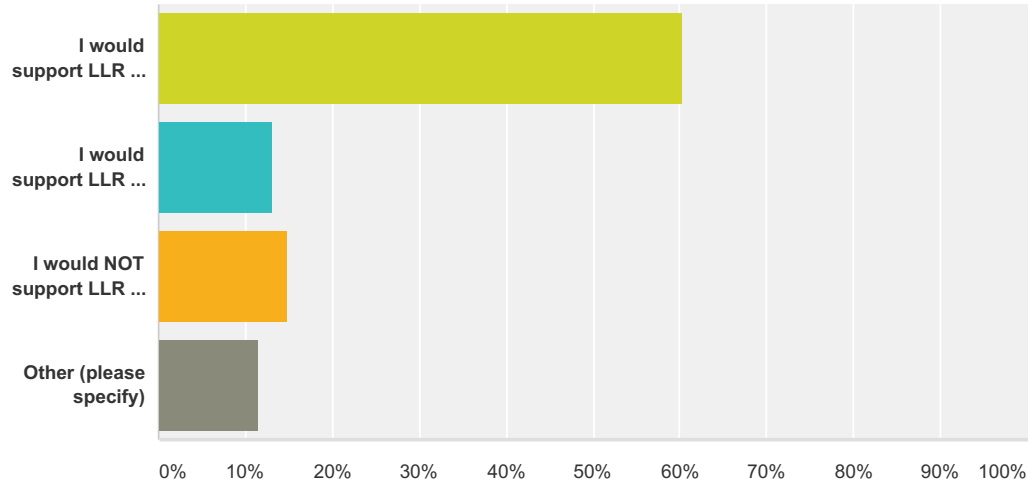
